




Dear guest, we would like to welcome you to Sealark Holiday Cottage. We hope you have an amazing holiday.

We do have a few house rules that we would like to let you know about. We ask you to kindly respect these rules. Thank you very much



We kindly ask that outdoor shoes are not worn upstairs to keep our upstairs carpets clean. Bring your slippers and start enjoying your property from the moment you arrive.



We hope that you have sunny weather on your holiday to allow you to use the courtyard Our patio cushions are kept in the garage. Please put the cushions back in the garage when you go out and overnight. The weather can change quickly because we are near the coast and we do not want the cushions to get wet and then go mouldy. Also, we have lots of seagulls flying over and we want to avoid them soiling the cushions!









We are sorry but we do not allow smoking, vaping or E-cigarettes either inside Sealark Cottage or in the gardens. This is part of our Fire Risk Assessment.



There are no candles or tea lights permitted in the property because of the risk of fire. This is a requirement of our insurance and Fire Risk Assessment. We have provided some fairly realistic battery-operated candles for you to use



Please only put toilet paper down the toilet. There is a bin in the bathroom for sanitary products etc.









Your cottage is located in a quiet and friendly village and we have neighbours. Please respect the privacy and peace of our neighbours and keep noise to a minimum especially during the evening and night – thank you. Our neighbours on both sides are friendly and will be happy to chat to you if you wish to do so.



We do not allow EV charging of any vehicle. We hope that this rule is fairly obvious because we do not have an EV charger. However, we have sadly had to include it because we have heard of horror stories where guests have run cables through windows and plugged into sockets within the house to charge their vehicles – very dangerous!









We love dogs and have 2 of our own who love coming on holiday to Sealark Cottage. We hope your dog will have a great waggy holiday. Please however observe these rules for dogs: -

Dogs are not allowed upstairs unless they are assistance dogs (this is because we have family and guests who have some allergies and we want to ensure that they can sleep well in a dog free environment)

Dogs must not be left unattended at the property. There are so many dog friendly places and eating establishments locally to visit – please see our guide or website for ideas

Dogs must be up to date with flea and worming treatments.

You will be liable for any damage caused by animals or parasites.
